## 400 Seat National Assembly in South Africa

- 1. A voter selects a single party
- 2. Allocate 200 seats to provinces using Droop quota with largest remainder based on number of registered voters
- 3. Allocate seats to parties within each province using Droop quota with largest remainder based on actual votes
- 4. Assign remaining 200 seats to parties based on national proportional representation

## 4. Assign remaining 200 seats to parties

- Based on national tallies:
  - Calculate Droop quota for 400 seats
  - ▶ If more allocation needed, allocate 5 highest remainders
  - If more allocation needed, assign based on average number of votes per seat
  - ▶ Determines total allocation to each party in the National Assembly
- ▶ Deduct seats won at regional level from national allocation Pick members from parties' national lists of candidates
